



WEATHER WATCH



Hot July brings cooling showers Strawberries and gilly-flowers



We certainly could do with a few cooling showers round here. It is hard to believe that Dover was flooded last week and we didn't have a drop! But be careful what we wish for, it might start and forget how to stop. We are enjoying the strawberries from our garden – one bonus of the drier weather is fewer slugs than last year.

A gillyflower is a carnation, dianthus or wallflower – all fragrant flowers. Gillyflowers were allegedly referenced as payment for peppercorn rent in medieval feudal-tenure contracts. You can make gillyflower wine, rather like we make elderflower cordial today.

July's weather can be stormy with amazing thunderstorms, or beautifully sunny. There is always the question whether it will rain on St Swithin's Day (15th July) when it said that it will then rain for the next 40 days? I don't think this has ever worked exactly but can be an indication of the future weather.

Our 60 year records show that the rainfall can vary from 140mm in 2007 or 122mm more recently in 2017. May 1982 only had 11mm, while 2022 was the driest ever with 0.2 mm and 2021 not far behind with 3.1mm. Who knows what 2025 will bring?

In May this year we had 18.5mm, well below the average of 54.9mm. As I write we are 100mm/4 inches behind the running total for the average year. This time last year, we were 150mm/6 inches ahead.

That's British weather for you!

Another word from the Copse

This spring, as we all know, has been hot and dry. Beautiful for most of us but not great for farmers! It must be such a challenge for anyone who works on the land. We've been watering and checking the 600+ whips and saplings we have planted over the past few years regularly - which is back breaking work but very necessary. We were delighted to find that we had only lost three this year, which is amazing.

(Someone did remove a number of them from along the bridleway, complete with stakes and protectors. We wonder where they ended up and hope they survived!)

Over the winter we coppiced about 100 square metres of hazel and have found the best way to protect the new growth from grazing by deer is to wrap them in chicken wire. While it is extremely expensive and not very pretty, we think we should be able to remove and reuse the chicken wire, making it quite a sustainable approach in the long term. It certainly seems to be more successful than using the brash to cover the stools as the deer simply push that out of the way.

If we let the deer have their way and eat all the new growth, the hazel will die and that leaves no home for the hazel dormouse to hibernate. So for the good of the whole woodland, this protection is crucial. And we think we have hazel dormice, but will be putting out footprint traps again a bit later in the season, to see if we can capture more evidence of them moving around the Copse.

But the really big news is about the conifers.

This news is scary! We have decided they have to go. They were planted as a crop, probably 70 years ago and have never been harvested.

Now, they are falling over in strong winds or the tops are being ripped off. The plantation is dangerous and all the debris on the floor is a fire risk which terrifies me. I regularly do a walk at dusk to ensure we don't have anyone having a party around a fire in there, as has happened on one occasion. A fireman we spoke to said it would all be gone within an hour if it caught fire and it could take so much more with it. The conifers are so dark, it is a wildlife desert under them. You can see that in the photograph.



Providing the ground remains dry and hard enough, they will go at the end of the bird nesting season. It will look brutal – there's no getting away from that. It will be disruptive as the heavy equipment will have to cross the bridleway to get the lumber out and it will be taken along footpaths to Little Aldershot from where it can be picked up by articulated lorry.

So, apologies for any inconvenience we will cause. Equipment used in the plantation will be heavy and we have accepted that the soil in there has been damaged in the past so disturbing the ground may

actually be beneficial, bringing old seed banks up to the surface and allowing the woodland to recover.

We will leave a bit of conifer at the southern end of the plantation where the trees are more sheltered as there are some birds that do need them, such as the gold and fire crests, coal tits and the raptors who all enjoy nesting in their lofty heights. Then, we need to put up deer fencing to protect new growth (for this we need to get a grant) and finally, we will be planting in excess of 3000 new broad leaved deciduous trees, as dictated by the Forestry Commission's licence. The trees will be planted either this winter or winter 26/27.

While we are at it, we already have permission to thin the whole canopy by up to 30%. Once the conifers have been removed, we will begin to take out other trees, but this work will be done in a considered way, more slowly, choosing the trees with care and using more gentle equipment in order to avoid soil compaction.

So, we hold our breath and wait to see the impact of the changes we are planning. It will change the appearance of the landscape, but hopefully, in time, it will be an improved place for wildlife.

REV. JILL'S JOTTINGS FOR JULY

Dear Readers.

Sunday June 15th is known in church as Trinity Sunday. Amongst much valuable guidance I was given whilst in training for the priesthood was this, "if you can avoid preaching on Trinity Sunday, do so!" The idea of the Trinity is complicated, indeed pretty inexplicable. How on earth can one God be three persons?

Thankfully after many helpful conversations with parishioners and after reading many books, I've learnt a bit. The word 'Persons', used in this context means characters, not individuals. It comes from a Greek word (personae) used when actors in plays used masks to represent the different characters in the play.



So speaking of God being 3 persons is a way of helping us to realise that there are three ways in which we might sense the reality of God.

- God the Creator and Sustainer. It is indeed through the wonder, beauty, complexity and mystery of the natural world that touches so many of us and gives us a sense of purpose over and above the world.
- 2) God the Son. A remarkable human being who has shown us as much as we can grasp of the nature and purposes of God.
- 3) God the Holy Spirit. God's living presence in the world acting through conscience, imagination, reason and guiding us into what the old prayer book describes as a godly, righteous and sober life.

So, one God, who reveals God's nature and reality in three different ways.

And finally, there are other '3s' we know of: past, present, future; or solid, liquid, gas; or the primary colours, red, blue, yellow. I find that intriguing.

And absolutely finally, the opening chapter of the Holy Bible tells us that we are created by God in God's image - 'male and female created he them.'




