





WEATHER WATCH



August brings the sheaves of corn





I love August – the feel of holiday time and memories of many a happy picnic in the harvest field, when we were farming. Sheaves of corn went out many years ago, so I have given you a picture of a bale of straw instead! Our garden is suddenly producing lots of delicious fruit and vegetables, thanks to all our watering with our syphoned-out bath water! Who needs to go to a gym when you can carry heavy cans of water around the garden.

The harvest in the fields is well under way as I write and may well be over by the time you read this. I remember when we were farming – one year we had finished harvest by Ist August and the following year we had not even started. I fear the yields will be well down as there has been no rain to swell the grains. Certainly there will be a lot less hay around for animals in the winter. We haven't mown our lawn for weeks.

So little rain has fallen in Ramsdell since 1^{st} March. Only 72mm in 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ months. I think I prefer that to the floods we have heard about on the news in Texas or Spain. It is reminiscent of 1976, but looking back at the figures we had 88mm during the same period in 1976.

The 60-year average rainfall for August is 61.8 mm at Wootton. The wettest years were 1999 with 135.3mm and 1992 with 133.5mm. The driest were 1995 with 12.1mm and 1976 with 13.1mm. Last year we had 28.5mm while in 2023 we had 100.5mm.


IN MY GARDEN

I do have some colour in the garden, the pink and white phlox are at their best and one good thing with the lack of water is the hostas have no slugs! In the wall by the patio the busy lizzies which were slow to get going are looking great now - thanks to watering! I have been watering everything.

In the vegetable garden our first early potatoes are good but we only had two helpings of broad beans - then they all dried up. We are harvesting sugar snap peas and courgettes. In the poly tunnel we are picking mini munch cucumbers and tomatoes. The butternut squash and water melons are growing well but we haven't had any fruit from them yet.

I do hope the weather gets a bit cooler - I haven't had a chance to cut the box and yew hedges yet it's been much too hot. Another benefit to the dry weather is that even the weeds have dried up. Perhaps by the time you read this we will have had some significant rain and plants will have a chance to recover.



I am a member of a Group called the Force [Hampshire Constabulary] Independent Advisory Group, which is the Hampshire Constabulary's sounding board to the public, I am involved with rural crime at all levels.

Today, as never before, our local security is in our own hands. Police budgets are in the same place as NHS, social care, defence, education. It is under extreme pressure. Do we expect too much from our police? Probably. Can we help more? Yes.

The key issue is the need for all of us to keep reporting all types of crime or unusual behaviour. We can do this either online (details below) or by telephoning 101. We need to be vigilant around our area. If we notice a vehicle or people who seem out of place – report it. The idea is to make our villages unfriendly to the 'ne'er do wells' by letting the police know. A seemingly unimportant fact to us, might help them solve a problem.

You can email our Dedicated Rural Officer PC (28153) Ulrike Maier -[ulrike.maier@hampshire.police.uk]. She looks after our area as part of her wider area. Or if you feel strongly about a Policing issue contact our Police Complaints Commissioner, Ms Donna Jones - [donna.jones@hampshire.police.uk]. She is responsible to us for Police performance in Hampshire.

Dear Parishioners,

Last week's Church Times once again carried the advertisement for a priest for your Benefice. I trust that in the fullness of time there will be an appointment. It prompted me to check my records to see when I began my monthly visits - December 2021. I've shared in a number of weddings, baptisms and funeral services, as well as Carol and Pet services, too. I have always beeen made very welcome - thank you and I count myself very blessed (at a somewhat advanced age!) still to be invited and capable of continuing.

Also spotted in last week's Church Times was an article about retired clergy. Apparently we take 40% of all Church of England services. We do not know what the future holds. Throughout its history and indeed over the course of my own life, Church has changed and developed.

There is always much to ponder. News of conflict, cruelty, terror and greed is plentiful. How it can all be resolved seems, humanly speaking, impossible. The Bible speaks of God exercising both justice and mercy, both qualities are needed for us to trust the word of Mother Julian of Norwich.
