

WEATHER WATCH



Indian summer breezes blow, the geese are taking flight
A soft glowing harvest moon lights up the starry night
The special warmth and happiness we feel about September
Will fill our hearts all winter long with beauty to remember

I heard some geese fly over the house a few nights ago and I realised that the year is moving along, and summer is coming to an end. We are nearing Autumn. The geese do have a wonderful calendar! I love September for its bountiful harvest in the gardens and hedgerows. We certainly are enjoying a good crop of plums, and the apple trees are laden with fruit to keep us going through the winter. The blackberries are good this year too. What a wonderful summer we have had – unless you are a gardener and are desperate for rain! At least we haven't had to mow the lawn for weeks!

People have likened this year to the drought of 1976. I have found the daily figures for 1976 at Wootton. It is true there was no rain at all from 22nd July till 27th August. It was then on and off for a few weeks and then it rained every single day for two months. The other difference was that in 1976 the year started much drier. January and February were very much drier that this year.

Over the years September rainfall has varied from a high of 176 mm in 1999 and 168mm in 1974 to as little as 7.1mm in 2014. The 60-year average at Wootton is 66.1mm.

July this year had 34mm, about half the average. We are now 120mm/5 inches short of the average running total for the year. This time last year we were well ahead.

But in spite of the dry weather the wall I planted up earlier is still full of colour from the busy lizzies and the fuschias are looking good too. In my pond I've never seen so many water lilies with their lovely pink and white flowers. The hostas are still looking good and there are no slugs! Perhaps this is due to a mixture of being in pots where they are easily watered and the dry weather.. The poor hydrangeas were good but they went over very quickly because of the heat.

In the vegetable garden Geoff has just harvested the shallots. The potatoes are also good but the sugar snap peas didn't do much at all - we only had two helpings. The French beans are so, so and the tomatoes are OK as well. The mini munch cucumbers were good, then one plant just gave up and it looks like another is on the way out too. The courgettes are always good. But everything has had to be watered regularly to get any crop at all. So in spite of the lack of rain, the harvest has not been too bad providing we kept everything watered. And by the sound of the forecast we won't get much break from watering any time soon

The jobs I will be tackling now it's not quite so hot are cutting the box, yew and conifer hedges. Because of the dry summer they've not put on as much growth as they do in a wet summer (that's one benefit of a dry summer). And I have lots of plants in pots that have been waiting all summer to go in my new bed - so when it finally rains I'll be busy getting them planted.

BECAUSE CHILDHOOD CAN'T WAIT!

REV. JILL'S JOTTINGS

Dear Parishioners,

I am writing this piece in mid-August. August, the traditional month for holidays - the schools are closed, the prices go up and many places are seriously overcrowded! However it is a great thing to visit somewhere different and to make good memories to bring home. Holidays began as Holy Days. Thousands of years ago, the great leader of the Hebrews, Moses, was given 10 rules for community living. One of them set the pattern for a regular rest day - the seventh day of each week, known as the Sabbath. It was (and is) observed as a day for worship and for rest. The early christian community, to distinguish themselves, chose the first day of the seven-day week for their Holy Day.

The tradition of visiting holy places is ancient too, for example the holy city of Jerusalem where Jesus himself went as a pilgrim. For his followers the places Jesus visited were holy. Not just Jerusalem but Bethlehem and Nazareth. Over the centuries other places were associated with holy men and women such as Rome, Compostela, Lourdes, Canterbury and nearer to home Winchester and Salisbury. A journey to such a place was a way of being in touch with God and some of his followers.

Today people still visit holy places. An open church with a visitors book will show that our churches in the Benefice are signs of God's interest and presence. Places that hold history and memories for many. Places to visit at significant moments in life, to find peace and welcome in a busy and sometimes confusing world.

Maintaining a church building is a struggle both financially and at a practical level but the buildings are very much needed in our communities and by those who visit - thanks to everyone who supports their upkeep, keep up the Good Work.

Is your Parish meeting local housing needs?

Many rural communities are facing a quiet crisis. Local people - those who grew up in the village, work nearby, or have family ties, are increasingly unable to find homes they can afford. Without action, rural communities risk losing the very people who keep them thriving.

Action Hampshire is a local charity which provides Rural Housing Enabling (RHE) services to support communities and parish councils to deliver the homes needed in their community. They act as an independent advisor providing impartial assistance to develop affordable and community led housing for people with a local connection and work with and on behalf of rural communities to address the shortage of affordable homes within the parish. These homes can be for rent or sale, and eligibility for occupancy is based on a strong local connection,.

Why it matters

Hampshire has a serious housing affordability gap. Property prices are high, while wages are below average, in 2023, the median house price was 10 times the average wage. Unlike general housing developments, rural affordable housing built on rural exception sites is reserved for people with a local connection. Rural Exception Sites are small plots of land just outside or adjacent to village boundaries that are permitted as exceptions to standard planning rules because they meet a proven local need.

What can you do?

Even if you're not directly affected you can help raise awareness and encourage local action:

- Speak to your Parish Council Ask them to contact Action
 Hampshire to request a free Parish Housing Profile for your area.
- Support a Housing Need Survey This survey identifies the type and amount of housing needed locally. These are usually commissioned by your Parish Council and can be carried out by Action Hampshire.
- 3. Know a local Landowner? If you know someone with land near the village, they might be interested in offering it as a Rural Exception Site. Ask them to get in touch with Action Hampshire.
